

## **Privacy Notice for the Processing of Personal Data 'ConTech Call Competition'**

**MEXT: Mota-Engil Next (MEXT)** is committed to guaranteeing the security and privacy of your personal data. Accordingly, this **Privacy Notice for the Processing of Personal Data** describes the privacy and security practices that **MEXT** has implemented in the collection and processing of personal data of the representatives of the applications within the scope of the 'ConTech Call Competition'.

The aim of this document is to provide information to data holders about themselves starting from collection, retention, and motive for processing as per art. 13 and 14 of the (UE) Regulation 2016/679 and the Council dated 27 April 2016 regarding the protection of private individuals as to their personal data processing and free circulation of such data – hereinafter known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) which shall be a part of the Mota-Engil Code of Ethics and the Code of Business Conduct.

Private individuals' data provided through a specific form as well as any other personal data provided by any means whatsoever to **MEXT** or any other controller appointed to that effect as well as any data generated through that process or that have been approved shall be dealt with by **MEXT** as the controller in charge of data processing.

The **MEXT** may also collect data pertaining to data holders from sources publicly available, public services and points of contact provided by the data holder to add to or confirm the data provided by data holders within said processing needs.

### **1. IDENTIFYING THE DATA CONTROLLER**

The **MEXT** is the data controller in charge of collecting and processing data from private holders and shall therefore and as per applicable regulations decide which personal data are to be collected, the processing means and the purpose.

### **2. COLLECTED DATA**

Following personal data will be collected within this process and strictly for **MEXT** in-house purposes:

- REPRESENTATIVE OF THE APPLICATION | name of representative(s), name of founder(s), company, position or function, e-mail, contact details.

Some of the data requested from the holder within the scope of this process may constitute a mandatory requirement, so if this is the case, **MEXT** will provide the holder with this indication.

Some data required from the data holder within this process may be a legal requirement and **MEXT** will therefore advise the holder accordingly.

### 3. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING

The personal data in question will be processed for the purpose(s) of analysing the formal eligibility conditions of the project promoters and evaluation based on the objectives of the programme - in accordance with the provisions of the '*ConTech Call Regulation*'.

### 4. LAWFULNESS OF PROCESSING

**MEXT** guarantees that it processes the data subject's personal data on the following lawful grounds:

- Performance of a contract or for pre-contractual diligence (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR);
- Fulfilment of a legal obligation (Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR);

### 5. RETENTION PERIOD

Personal data will be kept by **MEXT** for the time necessary to fulfil the above-mentioned purpose(s) - unless the applicable legal provisions establish other retention periods.

### 6. DATA TRANSFER

Holder's personal data may be processed by other GME companies. Data transfer to third countries will only occur if conditions are met to ensure proper the protection level to data holders and only according to applicable laws and regulations.

### 7. RIGHTS OF DATA HOLDERS

The data subject may exercise this right with **MEXT**:

- **RIGHT OF ACCESS** | the data subject has the right, subject to due exceptions, to obtain confirmation from **MEXT** as to whether or not personal data concerning him/her is being processed and, if so, the right to access it;
- **RIGHT TO RECTIFICATION** | the data subject has the right, with due exceptions, to obtain from **MEXT** the rectification (updating and correction) of inaccurate personal data concerning him/her;
- **RIGHT TO DELETION** - the data subject has the right, subject to due exceptions, to obtain from **MEXT** the erasure of his/her personal data (right to be forgotten);

- **RIGHT TO LIMITATION OF PROCESSING** - the data subject has the right, subject to appropriate exceptions, to obtain from **MEXT** the limitation, under the conditions laid down by law, of the processing of personal data concerning him/her;
- **RIGHT OF PORTABILITY** | the data subject has the right, subject to due exceptions, to obtain from **MEXT** the personal data concerning him/her, in a structured, commonly used and automatically readable format, and the right to transmit this data to another data controller without the data controller to whom the personal data was provided being able to prevent this;
- **RIGHT TO OPPOSE** - the data subject has the right, with due exceptions, to cease the processing of data carried out by **MEXT**;
- The data subject can request more detailed information, namely on the purposes, legal grounds and retention periods, as well as submit complaints to **MEXT** about the way in which their personal data is processed (see the 'Contacts' chapter), without prejudice to also being able to do so with the competent authority.

The law establishes the terms in which the above rights may be exercised, which shall be applicable at the time they are exercised by **MEXT**, including the exceptions and limitations to which they are subject.

## 8. OBLIGATION OF THE DATA HOLDER

The data holder must use the platform in a meaningful and responsible manner, and they shall be responsible for any corrections or updates as to the data provided which must also true data.

## 9. SECURITY

**MEXT** has implemented technical and operational security standards, as well as organisational, policies, procedures and internal controls aimed at protecting personal data against loss, misuse, alteration, or destruction. Only authorised persons at **MEXT** and our external service providers have access to personal data, and these employees and external service providers are obliged to treat this information as confidential.
